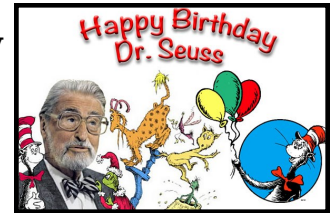

#### Gleaners Cooking Class for Teens

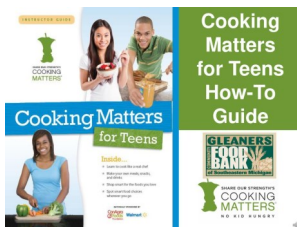

**with Marge Sapp**

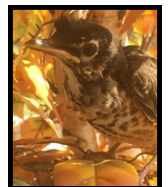
