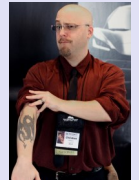
### Job training program for people with autism Tuesday November 6 @ 6:30pm

Great Lakes Horror Writing Assn. Michigan's horror writing community arrive at the library for an evening of stories & advise on writing scary tales.

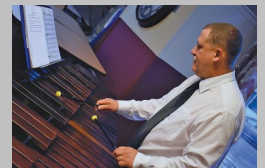
